 - The types of accomplishments your Nominee has achieved. Have others recognized them for their achievements? If so, how?
 - Provide noteworthy examples of leadership provided by your Nominee at the local, provincial, national and/or international levels.
 - How did they serve as a role model or mentor for others?

You may also include additional supporting documentation about your Nominee such as copies of publications, lists of achievements/awards, etc. Photocopies of other awards need not be included, simply list them in the Nominee's personal biography.
